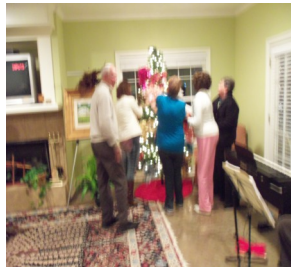
DEAR FRIEND;
